Cal Long-Term Care Compare

Cal Long Term Care Compare (CLTCC)

Purpose:

 Website provides comparative data for California nursing homes, home health and hospice facilities

Value Proposition:

 Helping consumers select long-term care facilities for their family and loved ones by providing data on the quality of care at skilled nursing facilities (SNF), home health agencies, and hospice agencies as well as information on types of care offered at assisted living facilities, continuing care retirement communities, and adult day health centers.



Purpose

Accelerate quality improvement

Promote resident centered care



Align payment, services, and quality







Measures that Matter

- Mobility and function measures for LS and SS were evaluated to construct composite measures
 - LS composite: 8 measures
 - SS composite: 5 measures
- Identified top 25% of performers for SS & LS
 - **Top Tier:** Includes facilities that fall into the top 10% measure performance group
 - Second Tier: Includes facilities that fall into the next 15% measure performance group
 - Third Tier: Includes facilities that fall into the bottom 75% measure performance group

MTM Guardrails

- CMS special focus facility or candidate on CMS watch list
- Any CMS rating of 1 or 2 stars
- Bottom 10% performance group in the program's LS composite or SS composite
- CMS abuse icon (based on manual review by the research team)
- State AA or A citations in the last 3 years (based on manual review by the research team)

Results

- Among the 933 SNFs in the Long-Stay and 928 SNFs in the Short-Stay performance group, with guardrails applied:
 - 103 SNFs recognized in top 25% of long stay facilities
 - **27** were in the top 10%
 - * 70 SNFs recognized in top 25% of short stay facilities
 - **47** were in the top 10%
 - 1 SNF was Top 10% in both groups: Arroyo Grande Care Center

About 43% of SS and 58% of LS SNFs excluded from the top 10% due to CMS 1- or 2- star designation in any domain

10 SNFs underwent manual review of state citations; all were excluded
